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Dear Mr. Ohlmann:

Commissioner Marsh has asked me to respond to your petition of June 22, 1994 requesting that the boundary of the subject site be modified (portion of) to exclude the area located north of Central Avenue/Sheridan Avenue Intersection, Section 46, Block 323, portion of Lot 17E (known as the Central Avenue Site); and northwest of Stewart Avenue/Cherry Avenue Intersection, Section 46, Block G, Lots: 49 (partial), 50, 51, 52 (known as the Buildings 30 and 35 site), at Hicksville, New York in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites in New York State (The Registry).

We are pleased to inform you that we are accepting the first part of the petition to modify the boundaries of the Grumman Aerospace Corporation site by excluding the area known as the Central Avenue Site.

However, we are rejecting the petition for the area known as the Buildings 30 and 35 Site without prejudice for resubmittal, per 6NYCRR Part 375-1.9(c) for the reason of incompleteness. Another round of groundwater sampling should be done to provide current information on the levels of contaminants in the groundwater. The presence of a high level of chromium (1340 ppb) in well P-2 is an area of concern. This well should be re-developed or reconstructed and sampled again. The drinking water standards for chromium and lead are 50 ppb and 25 ppb, respectively. Table 4-5 needs to be revised accordingly.

The "approximate" direction of groundwater flow (Figure 3-1) needs to be changed. The Remedial Investigation Report prepared by Geraghty and Miller should be used as a source of groundwater contours.
