Site History and Summary of Environmental Activity

Site Background

- 1962, Bethpage Community Park property donated to the Town of Oyster Bay by Grumman Aircraft Engineering Corporation, a predecessor to Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation (Grumman).
- 1964, Park constructed and opened for public use.
- 2002, Select areas of the Park closed following the identification of historical contamination in site soils.
- 2003, Limited soil and groundwater investigation work conducted by Grumman.

Recent Site Investigation and Remediation Activity

Construction Area

- March 2005, Town of Oyster Bay enters into an Order on Consent with the New York State
 Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) to expedite a thorough site investigation
 and remediation program for an approx. 7-acre portion of the Park designated as the
 Construction Area.
- September 2005, Town completes site investigation.
- November 2005, Town submits proposed Remedial Action Plan to NYSDEC for approval.
- March 2006, Town submits revised Remedial Action Plan to NYSDEC.
- May 2006, NYSDEC approves Remedial Action Plan for Construction Area.
- Currently, Town plans to remediate Construction Area soils and construct a new ice rink facility.

Balance of Park (Including Ball Field)

- June 2005, Grumman enters into an Order on Consent with the NYSDEC to investigate the remaining areas of the Park.
- June 2005, Grumman initiates first phase of a multiphase site investigation.
- April 2006, Grumman initiates second phase of the multiphase site investigation.
