

Weekly Construction Progress Report Work

Period: 7/26/21 thru 7/30/21

Project Work Performed:

- Performed Community Air Monitoring with no reportable exceedances.
- Performed noise monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Notified residents of work activities in their area on a daily basis.
 Continued trench excavation from the Utility Corridor onto Sophia St to near N Herman Ave. At
- the end of the week, approximately 200 feet of trench was excavated. Continued installation of 8"x12" HDPE pipe and two 3" PVC conduits from the Utility Corridor onto
- Sophia St. At the end of the week, approximately 150 feet of pipe and conduit was installed.
- Installed traffic control signs on and near Stewart Ave.
- Installed additional storm drain silt protection along trench route.
- Completed fusion weld between existing and new HDPE pipes in the Utility Corridor.
- Began backfilling and compacting trench in the Utility Corridor and across Sophia St.

- Continue to notify residents of work activities in their area. - Continue trench excavation and HDPE pipe installation on

- Continue backfilling and compacting trench on Sophia St. - Begin trench excavation at intersection of S Pershing Ave and

- · Completed piping in RW-20, RW-21, and RW-22 vaults, including successfully pressure testing
- installed piping and fittings. Began electrical work at RW-22 vault.
