

Weekly Construction Progress Report Work Period: 11/1/21 **thru** 11/5/21

Project Work Performed:

- Performed Community Air Monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Performed noise monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Notified residents and local businesses of work activities in their area on a daily basis.
- Completed trench excavation on S Pershing Ave. Began trench excavation on Brenner Ave. At the end of the week, an additional approximately 200 feet of trench was excavated.
- Completed installing 16"x24" HDPE influent pipe on S Pershing Ave. Began HDPE pipe installation on Brenner Ave. At the end of the week, an additional approximately 360 feet of pipe was installed.
- Installed an additional approximately 350 feet of binder coarse asphalt on S Pershing Ave near the Brenner Ave intersection.
- Began installing traffic control signs/devices and utility location on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave.
- Continued electrical installation at the RW-20 and RW-22 vaults. At RW-20, installed a new pull box and connected to the previously installed conduits at the east end of William St.

- Continue trench excavation on Brenner Ave.
- Begin trench excavation on S Sheridan Ave.

- Begin backfilling/compacting trench and installing binder coarse asphalt on Brenner Ave.
- Complete utility location on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave.
- Sawcut pavement and begin trench excavation on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave.
- Continue electrical installation at the RW-20 vault.
