

Weekly Construction Progress Report

Project Work Performed:

- Performed Community Air Monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Performed noise monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Notified residents and local businesses of work activities in their area on a daily basis.
- Completed trench excavation on Brenner Ave and began trench excavation on S Sheridan Ave. At the end of the week, an additional approximately 100 feet of trench was excavated.
- Completed installing 16"x24" HDPE influent pipe on Brenner Ave. At the end of the week, an additional approximately 245 feet of pipe was installed.
- Installed an additional approximately 200 feet of binder coarse asphalt on Brenner Ave.
- Completed installing traffic control signs/devices and utility location on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave.
- Sawcut pavement and began trench excavation on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave. At the end of the week, approximately 30 feet of trench was excavated.
- Continued electrical installation at the east end of William St for the RW-20 vault.

- Begin HDPE pipe installation on Central Ave between Seaman Ave and N Herman Ave.
