

# **Weekly Construction Progress Report Work Period:** 11/29/21 **thru** 12/3/21

## **Project Work Performed:**

- Performed Community Air Monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Performed noise monitoring with no sustained exceedances.
- Notified residents and local businesses of work activities in their area on a daily basis.
- Completed fusing 16"x24" HDPE influent pipe on S Sheridan Ave.
- Completed HDPE pipe installation on S Sheridan Ave. At the end of the week, an additional approximately 205 feet of pipe was installed.
- Installed an additional approximately 210 feet of binder coarse asphalt on S Sheridan Ave.
- Installed air release and leak detection manholes on S Sheridan Ave.
- Began hydrostatic testing of previously installed piping.
- Began installing traffic control signs/devices and initiated utility location test pitting on Central Ave between S Sheridan Ave and Hickey Blvd.

# Work Projected Next Period:

- Continue Community Air Monitoring.
- Continue noise monitoring.
- Continue to notify residents and local businesses of work activities in their area on a daily basis.
- Continue hydrostatic testing of previously installed piping.
- Sawcut pavement and begin trench excavation on Central Ave between S Sheridan Ave and Hickey Blvd.
