

# NAVY PROJECT ROAD CLOSURE ANNOUNCEMENT

Contractors working on behalf of the United States Navy, under agreement with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), continue construction on a groundwater remediation (i.e. clean-up) project thru the Spring 2009. The GM-38 Area Groundwater Remediation project includes a pre-engineered steel building that is was constructed within the utility easement that is located east of Broadway Ave., west of the Seaford –Oyster Bay Expressway (Route 135), and between the north and south dead ends of Windhorst and Herman Avenues. The construction entrance to the treatment building is located on the eastern side of Broadway Avenue (just south of Arthur Avenue) between residences at 106 Broadway and 96 Broadway. **DURING THE WEEK OF APRIL 13, 2009 WORK WILL OCCUR WITHIN BROADWAY RESULTING IN A ROAD CLOSURE OF BROADWAY AT A LOCATION JUST SOUTH OF THE ARTHUR AVENUE INTERSECTION.** Detours will direct traffic to Stewart Avenue during the time of road closure. Traffic traveling south on Broadway will be detoured to the west on Arthur Ave. to the intersection with Stewart Avenue. Traffic traveling north on Broadway will be detoured to the west on Wilson Lane toward the Adams Gate intersection with Stewart Avenue. A map of the road closure location is enclosed with this announcement. Road closure work will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The road will be open to traffic overnight. Work within the roadway is to be completed within a week.
