



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

September 1, 2020

Please be advised that the Department of the Navy (Navy), in conjunction with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), will be conducting environmental remedial action activities near Arthur Avenue starting in September 2020. An underground pipeline will be installed parallel to Arthur Avenue to transport contaminated groundwater from a new groundwater recovery well located near Hicksville Road. The pipeline route will be from the new well to Navy's GM-38 Groundwater Treatment Plant located to the east of Broadway Road underneath the power lines. The Navy is undertaking this construction as part of the ongoing remediation of the Navy-Northrop Grumman plume in this area.

The work will involve the excavation of a trench and placement of a double-walled pipe. The pipe will be buried and monitored remotely for leak detection. The pipeline alignment was developed along the south side of Arthur Avenue, primarily behind the fence line. The alignment was routed to impact the smallest number of existing mature trees, and caution will be taken to minimize tree removal outside of the pipeline alignment.

The Navy and its contractors are taking all reasonable steps to minimize disruption to you and your neighbors during remedial action activities. Heavy equipment will only be operated between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, to limit noise disturbance. If it is necessary to visit the work site during other hours or weekends, activities will be kept to a minimum. Construction activities along Arthur Avenue are expected to be completed in October 2020.
