



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

March 3, 2021

The Department of the Navy (Navy) is providing this update on the progress of construction that has been ongoing near your residences. At this time, installation of the pipeline, a new groundwater recovery well, and associated utilities have been completed. Removed asphalt has been patched in anticipation of repaving during Spring 2021. Until weather conditions are suitable for repaving, construction personnel will depart the work area however construction equipment and temporary facilities will remain in place.

During the repaving activity, vehicle access and parking will be restricted. Cones or other temporary barricades will be placed as needed to ensure access by the Navy's contractors. The construction contractor will provide additional instructions for residents prior to beginning the paving.

The Navy and its contractors are taking all reasonable steps to minimize disruption to you and your neighbors during remedial action activities. Heavy equipment will only be operated between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, to limit noise disturbance. If it is necessary to visit the work site during other hours or weekends, activities will be kept to a minimum.
