Re: TCLP Analytical Results for Sump 1 Tank Rubble
Hooker Chemical/Ruco Polymer Corporation Site
Hicksville, New York

The concrete tank in Sump 1 was demolished and placed in covered rolloffs the week of October 23, 2000. The rolloffs are currently staged on-site.

The TCLP results are listed in Table 1. A complete listing of the analytical results is presented in Attachment A. The results show that the chemical concentrations are below regulatory levels and the concrete rubble is non-hazardous. Thus, it is planned to ship the rubble to the CWM facility located in Model City, New York under a non-hazardous waste manifest.

It is planned to ship the rubble on November 13, 2000. Thus, EPA's prompt concurrence with respect to the method of shipping and disposal described above would be greatly appreciated.
