ACTION THIS MONTH

- Bayer responded to September 9, 2010 e-mail correspondence dated September 9, 2010 from the
 United States Environmental Protection Agency regarding the "draft" Corrective Measures Study
 Report ("the CMS Report") and the anticipated future zoning of the property.
- Bayer requested a walk-through of Simone Development (Simone) property in September 16, 2010 e-mail correspondence to Simone. In September 21, 2010 e-mail correspondence, Simone suggested a possible walk-through of Simone property at a later date but did not grant a walk-through in connection with the September 28, 2010 site meeting.
- Bayer attended a September 28, 2010 site meeting with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), and ARCADIS to meet new individuals involved in the project, conduct a site walk, observe current conditions, discuss preliminary comments on the "draft" Corrective Measures Study Report ("the CMS Report"), and discuss next steps of the soil vapor intrusion investigation, including offsite sub-slab vapor and indoor air sampling.
- ARCADIS completed revisions to the soil vapor intrusion background information search summary letter that summarizes information obtained and reviewed relating to the use of the commercial/industrial buildings located south of Bayer property (including volatile organic compound [VOC] generation, use, storage, handling, transportation, disposal, and spills).
- ARCADIS started to prepare a letter responding to Simone comments on the CMS Report.

DELIVERABLES THIS MONTH

 The background information search summary letter was sent to the NYSDEC and NYSDOH on October 1, 2010.

ACTION NEXT MONTH

- Bayer will continue to pursue access to Simone property for indoor air and sub-slab sampling.
- ARCADIS will prepare a work plan for the vapor intrusion investigation at the Simone warehouse
 facility east of the Bayer sites. The work plan will describe: (1) a building reconnaissance and product
 inventory (to look for potential migration pathways and potential VOC sources inside the building); (2)
 an interview with building facility manager(s) to discuss information about the building construction
 and operations; and (3) sampling of sub-slab soil vapor and indoor air (at locations adjusted, as
 needed, based on findings of Steps 1 and 2).
- A letter responding to Simone comments on the CMS Report will be submitted to Simone.

- A conference call with the NYSDEC, NYSDOH, Bayer, and ARCADIS will be held to discuss agency comments on the CMS Report.
- ARCADIS will prepare a letter responding to agency comments on the CMS Report (if necessary), and once agreement is reached between the NYSDEC and Bayer, ARCADIS will revise and finalize the CMS Report for NYSDEC review and approval.
