# RCRA CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM BAYER MATERIALSCIENCE LLC 125 NEW SOUTH ROAD HICKSVILLE, NEW YORK

### **ACTION THIS MONTH**

- ARCADIS began preparing a work plan for the vapor intrusion (VI) investigation at the Simone
  Development (Simone) warehouse facility east of the Bayer site. The work plan will describe: (1) a
  building reconnaissance and product inventory (to look for potential migration pathways and potential
  volatile organic compound (VOC) sources inside the building); (2) an interview with building facility
  manager(s) to discuss information about the building construction and operations; and (3) sampling of
  sub-slab soil vapor and indoor air (at locations adjusted, as needed, based on findings of Steps 1 and
  2).
- ARCADIS began preparing a letter responding to New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), and United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) comments on the Corrective Measures Study Report ("the CMS Report"). A conference call with the NYSDEC, NYSDOH, USEPA, Bayer, and ARCADIS was scheduled for November 16, 2010 to discuss agency comments on the CMS Report.
- ARCADIS began revising the CMS Report based on NYSDEC, NYSDOH, and USEPA comments.

# **DELIVERABLES THIS MONTH**

 The letter responding to New South Road Realty's (NSRR's) comments on the CMS Report was submitted to NSRR and the NYSDEC on October 20, 2010.

### **ACTION NEXT MONTH**

- ARCADIS will continue to prepare a letter responding to agency comments on the CMS Report, and once agreement is reached between the NYSDEC and Bayer, ARCADIS will revise and finalize the CMS Report for NYSDEC review and approval.
- ARCADIS will complete preparation of the above-mentioned VI investigation work plan.
- A conference call with the NYSDEC, NYSDOH, USEPA, Bayer, and ARCADIS will be held to discuss agency comments on the CMS Report.
- Bayer will continue to pursue access to Simone property for indoor air and sub-slab sampling.

# **SCHEDULE CHANGES**
