RCRA CORRECTIVE ACTION PROGRAM BAYER MATERIALSCIENCE LLC 125 NEW SOUTH ROAD HICKSVILLE, NEW YORK

ACTION THIS MONTH

- The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) issued the Record of Decision (ROD) on December 19, 2012.
- Bayer selected a remedial contractor (EQ) and onsite engineer (ARCADIS) for implementation and construction oversight, respectively, of the final remedy.

DELIVERABLES THIS MONTH

- No project-related deliverables were submitted to the NYSDEC or New York State Department of Health in December 2012.

ACTION NEXT MONTH

- ARCADIS will revise the RD, as needed, based on NYSDEC's review, and then issue a final PE-stamped version of the RD following receipt of NYSDEC approval.
- Bayer plans to execute a contract with the remedial contractor for mobilization to begin in later January 2013.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

- There were no significant schedule changes in December 2012 that may impact the existing overall project schedule.
