# OPERABLE UNIT 04 REMEDIAL ACTION BAYER MATERIALSCIENCE LLC 125 NEW SOUTH ROAD HICKSVILLE, NEW YORK

#### **ACTION THIS MONTH**

- Bayer's remedial contractor (Posillico Environmental, Inc.) continued to perform weekly inspections of the erosion and sedimentation (E&S) control measure at the Site until vegetation is established to project specifications (80% density of perennial vegetation over the entire disturbed areas).
- ARCADIS reviewed and provided comments on "draft" as-built survey drawings provided by Posillico.
- ARCADIS addressed Bayer and OxyChem comments on the "draft" Site Management Plan (SMP) and submitted the revised SMP to New South Road Realty (NSRR) for review.
- ARCADIS continued to work on the Final Engineering Report (FER).

### **DELIVERABLES THIS PERIOD**

ARCADIS submitted the June 2015 monthly progress report to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) on June 8, 2015.

## **ACTION NEXT MONTH**

- Posillico will continue to perform the weekly inspections of the E&S control measures at the Site. It is anticipated that vegetation may be sufficiently established by mid-to-late July 2015 for E&S control measures to be removed.
- ARCADIS will review revised as-built survey drawings to be provided by Posillico.
- Bayer will continue to work on the Environmental Easement for submittal to the NYSDEC.
- ARCADIS will address comments on the SMP from NSRR (if received) and then issue the SMP to the NYSDEC for review.
- ARCADIS will continue to work on the FER.

### **SCHEDULE CHANGES**

A revised project schedule was submitted to the NYSDEC on March 19, 2015. Work is generally proceeding on schedule. An updated project schedule will be provided to the NYSDEC in late July/early August 2015.
