MONTHLY PROGRESS REPORT – DECEMBER 2015

OPERABLE UNIT 04 REMEDIAL ACTION COVESTRO LLC (fka BAYER MATERIALSCIENCE LLC) 125 NEW SOUTH ROAD HICKSVILLE, NEW YORK

ACTION THIS MONTH

- Arcadis continued revising the "draft" Final Engineering Report (FER) and "draft" Site Management Plan (SMP) based on partial comments received from Covestro and Bayer.
- Bayer's remedial contractor (Posillico Environmental) removed the Operable Unit 4 (OU4) remedial action project sign from the Site on December 18, 2015.

DELIVERABLES THIS PERIOD

- Arcadis submitted the November 2015 monthly progress report to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) on December 10, 2015.
- Arcadis prepared a professional engineer (PE) certification for an Arcadis letter to the Deputy
 Commissioner of the Town of Oyster Bay Planning Department that summarizes the demolition and
 remediation work performed at the Site. The letter had been submitted to the Town on September 15,
 2015 in support of Bayer's request to close-out the two open demolition permits for the Site. The
 certification was stamped and signed by an Arcadis PE licensed in New York State and was e-mailed
 to the Town on December 23, 2015 pursuant to the Town's December 21, 2015 request to Bayer.

ACTION NEXT MONTH

- Covestro anticipates completing preparation of the Environmental Easement (EE) package and submitting it to the NYSDEC for review/processing.
- Covestro anticipates receiving results of the OU5 soil vapor investigation work (performed by GHD) and submitting a report to the NYSDEC that summarizes the findings.
- Arcadis will work on further revisions to the "draft" SMP and "draft" FER following receipt of results for the OU5 soil vapor investigation work and receipt of remaining SMP/FER review comments from Covestro/Bayer.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

Covestro anticipates submitting both the "draft" SMP and "draft" FER to the NYSDEC in the first quarter of 2016.
