State Superfund Site Reclassification Notice Class 02 to Class 04

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program is New York State's superfund program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (Registry). The site identified above, and located on the attached map, has been reclassified on the Registry as a Class 4 site as it no longer presents a significant threat to public health and/or the environment for the following reason(s):

- Remedial activities at the site included: excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soils exceeding
 applicable cleanup standards; in-situ (i.e., in place) chemical treatment through oxidation of residual
 groundwater contamination; and, maintenance of a site cover system.
- Human exposures to residual soil contaminants are being addressed through the implementation of an
 environmental easement on the property, which requires: limited use and development of the property;
 compliance with the approved Site Management Plan; compliance with an Excavation Plan to manage
 potential exposures to residual contamination; restricted use of groundwater at the property; maintenance
 of the site cover system; and annual certification that the institutional and engineering controls at the
 property remain in place and effective.


