

P.W. Grosser Consulting, Inc. (PWGC) has prepared this report to document closure activities of the above-referenced site's Class V Underground Injection Control (UIC) leaching structures.

The site is currently a Class II Inactive Hazardous Waste Site under NYSDEC oversight. Investigation activities continue at the site in an attempt to down-grade and/or delist the site from the NYSDEC registry.

On August 24, 2006, leaching structures DW-8, DW-9, and DW-10 were sampled by PWGC. Results of the investigation and sampling are detailed in the Sanitary Leaching Pool Closure Work Plan, prepared by PWGC in October 2006 and submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) under separate cover. The Closure Work Plan detailed UIC leaching structure investigation activities including a geophysical investigation, excavation of buried pools, and UIC sampling. Sampling of the three structures occurred on August 24, 2006. Results of the sampling indicated low concentrations of VOCs and SVOCs. Permanent abandonment was recommended for structures DW-8, DW-9, and DW-10 as they were no longer in use and apparently had not received improper discharge. The NCDH recommended approval of the Work Plan to the USEPA in a February 2007 letter. The USEPA also found the Work Plan acceptable in a March 2007 letter. These letters are included as **Appendix A**.

91 cubic yards of sand was delivered to the site on April 12, 2007 and stockpiled. On April 16, 2007, UIC structures DW-8, DW-9, and DW-10 were filled to grade with the clean sand. Approximately 60 cubic yards of sand was used to fill the structures. The remaining sand was removed from the site by the contractor. The covers of the structures were put back in place and paved over with asphalt. The receipt for the clean fill material is included as **Appendix B**. A PWGC hydrogeologist was on site to witness closure activities. Photographs of backfilling activities and final pavement are included in **Appendix C**.





EPA Form 7520-16, "Inventory of Injection Wells", is included as **Appendix D**. This form replaces the original Form 7520-16 submitted for the site, and reflects the current status of the site's injection wells.

Enclosed for your information are three (3) reports prepared by P.W. Grosser Consulting for the referenced site:

- 1. "Progress Report Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study" dated September 7, 2006.
- 2. "Progress Report Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study" dated October 5, 2006.
- 3. "Sanitary Leaching Pool Closure Work Plan" dated October 23, 2006.

The site in question is currently listed on the New York State Registry of Inactive Hazardous sites. Previous site work in 2003 included the remediation and/or closure of three (3) storm water drywells (DW-1, DW-2 and DW-3) and five (5) sanitary leaching structures (DW-4, DW-5, DW-6, DW-7 and A-1). EPA approved the remediations and/or closures in a November 12, 2003 letter to the property owner.

The enclosed reports provide information on three (3) newly located EPA designated Class V Underground Injection Wells at the site (DW-8, DW-9 and DW-10). We are currently reviewing the reports with respect to federal Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program requirements and will submit comments on same to you shortly.
