

July 8, 1952. Notice of hearing given by publication in

represented by Howard H. Plant, President. No objections
were filed and no appearance in opposition.

Labette Chemicals Corporation is a domestic corporation engaged in the manufacture of laboratory equipment, at its plant on the north side of Duffy Avenue, east of Charles Street, Hicksville, Nassau County.

Well water is desired for cooling manufacturing equipment in the plant. Water for drinking and sanitary purposes will be obtained from the municipal water supply.

A 69.4 gallon per minute supply well (N-3964) has been sunk in the central portion of this property. This well is of standard type with 6-inch diameter casing, about 180 feet deep. It is proposed to change the electrically operated deer well turbine pump whose present capacity is 69.4 gallons a minute to a similar type pump with a capacity of 100 gallons per minute.

Use of water will be at a rate of approximately 33,000 gallons a day and the annual use will not exceed 12 million gallons.

Water is to pass from the well through the existing system without obstruction and with no outlets or connections which would permit use of the water for other purposes. To a diffusion well to be located about 135 feet south of well N-3964.

This diffusion well will be constructed in accordance with the standards for such structures adopted by the well drillers. Details will be submitted for approval. It will be used for no other purpose.

It appears that to approve the above application will have no perceptible effect on the ground water levels of Long Island.

the Commission shall have the authority to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the State by the following conditions:


1. The location of any diffuser or approval applicant is authorized to draw water through from their well or wells for air-conditioning or cooling in the above described building, but for no other purpose whatsoever. This water shall be introduced in a completely closed system and all the water must be returned through the proposed diffuser well or wells or any other equivalent satisfactory structure to the same aquifer from which it was pumped.
2. No overflows or connections to sewers or cross-connections to any other source of water supply may be installed or maintained.
3. Detailed plans showing each part of this project must have been submitted to and approved by this Commission before work is started on such part. Plans of a diffuser shall be considered only after the stratification has been reversed by the sinking of the well. The entire project must be fully completed in accordance with approved plans.
4. Applicant must install suitable connections to enable the discharge of the pump to be measured. Such fittings and the locations thereof will be specified by the Commission.
5. No chemical or polluting substance may be discharged in this water or into the diffuser well and the material used in the piping of the cooling system shall be of a nature completely resistant to corrosion which would pollute the water and tend to clog the diffuser well.
6. This entire plant and the apparatus connected therewith must at all reasonable hours be open to inspection and test by duly accredited agents of this Commission and of the local water utility.
7. This approval and license shall not be held to grant exemption from general restrictions of the use of water. For this and other purposes which may at any time be imposed by public authority.
8. The Commission reserves the right to reconsider this approval on August 1, 1977, or on any later date and after a public hearing at that time to determine whether or not it is in the public interest in such case to amend, suspend, or terminate this approval.
9. This approval shall be completely executed prior to August 1, 1977, and any work which is started thereunder shall be completed by that date.

In view of the above and the Water Power and Control Commission's determination and decision that approval of this application will protect the public health and public welfare in connection with the supply of water for Long Island for domestic consumption.

WHEREFORE, the Water Power and Control Commission does hereby approve the said application, maps and plans as thus modified.

ON WITNESS WHEREOF, the Water Power and Control Commission has caused this determination and approval to be signed and has caused its official seal to be affixed hereto and has filed the same with all maps, plans, reports and other papers relating thereto in its office in the city of Albany this 23rd day of July, 1952.

It is proposed to sink a well at the point shown
in the accompanying plan. This well is to be 6 inches diameter,
and is to be about 100 ft. deep. An electrically operated deep well
pumping plant of 100 gallons per minute capacity is to be
installed. Pump capacity is to be 100 gallons per minute with
a daily use of approximately 30,000 gallons. The total
annual use from this well will not exceed 12 millions of
gallons. This is based on an operating period of 12 months
per year.

It is anticipated that this well water at this plant
will be used for cooling direct ice cream cups, during the
summer months, and therefore will be used for cooling purposes.
Although it is believed that sufficient can obtain the desired water
quantity from this well, it is recommended that from which
the desired quantity would be readily be available.

It is proposed to use this water in an economical
manner, and the clean cool water is to be diffused back into the
ground through a special non-effluent well to comply with Water
Pollution Control Act regulations.

Dear Sir:

We are sending you herewith formal approval of wells and permit to operate the same, issued by the Water Power and Control Commission on March 3, 1953.

An inspection of your well installation on February 5, 1953 by an engineer of this Commission revealed that the water used to wash the paint spray booths is being discharged into a pit located about 30 feet east of the supply well. This water is contaminated; the extent of which at the present is not known. Also, discharging the water so close to the supply well presents a possible source of contamination of chemicals contained in this water which could not be removed by filtration during percolation and be drawn into the supply well.

It is recommended that you make an investigation of the situation to determine what, if any, preventative measures may be taken.


Dear Sirs:
