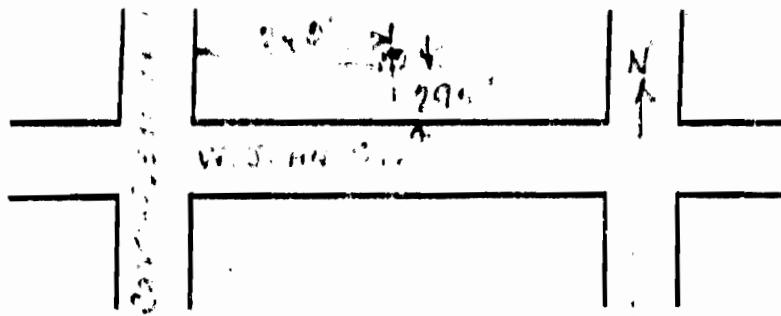

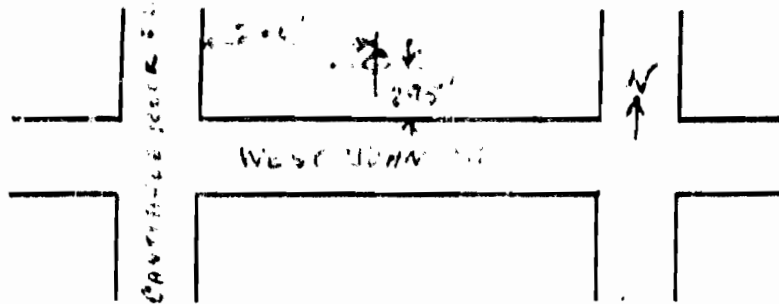

Petition verified by Jerry Spiegel, President of Edgecombe Construction Corp., on May 5, 1960, filed on May 10, 1960. Notice of hearing published in Newsday of Garden City. Hearing held before Walter G. Waterman, Senior Engineer of the Commission in the office of the Commission in Westbury on May 20, 1960 at 10 A.M. Applicant was represented at the hearing by the said Jerry Spiegel. No objections were filed and no one appeared at the hearing in opposition to approval of the project. The Nassau County Department of Public Works was represented at the hearing by Henry L. Frauenthal, Assistant Hydraulic Engineer.

Applicant owns a building located on the north side of West John Street and the east side of Cantiague Hook Road in Hicksville, Nassau County. This building is leased to the General Transistor Corp., who will use it for manufacturing purposes. The principal office of the applicant is at 270 North Broadway, Hicksville, New York.

Well water is desired for cooling air-conditioning machinery. Water for drinking and sanitary purposes is obtained from the Hicksville Water District.

In the early part of this year the applicant sunk well No. N-6860 on this property with an 8-inch diameter casing and screen, to a depth of 100 feet and authorization was given to equip this well with a pump having a capacity of 45 gallons a minute. No pump has been installed to date.

Applicant finds that the capacity of well No. N-6860, as originally proposed, will be inadequate for air-conditioning purposes, and now requests authority to increase the capacity of this well from 45 to 150 gallons a minute by installing a larger pumping unit in the well.

The daily use of well water in the plant will be approximately 55,000 gallons during the summer cooling season of about 100 days, and the annual use will not exceed 55 million gallons.

Water is to pass from the well through the cooling system without contamination and with no outlets or connections which would permit use of the water for other purposes, to a diffusion well to be located about 200 feet southwest of the supply well.

The diffusion well is to be constructed in accordance with the standards for such structures adopted by the well drillers. Details will be submitted for approval. It will be used for no other purpose.

Since all of the well water is to be returned to the same aquifer pumped, there will be no net loss to the underground strata.

It appears that to approve the above application will have no perceptible effect on the ground water levels of Long Island.

The Commission finds it to be necessary to protect the interests of the applicant and of the people of the State to impose the following conditions:

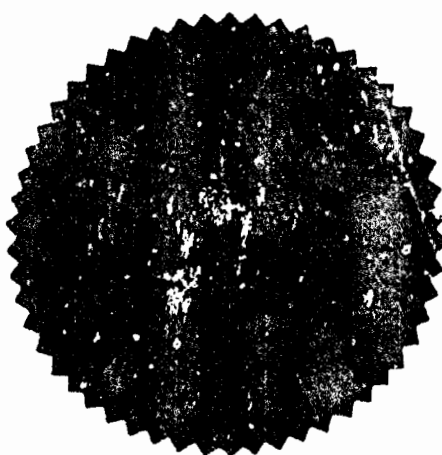
1. By authority of this decision and approval applicant is authorized to use water pumped from this well or wells for airconditioning or cooling in the above described building but for no other purpose whatsoever. This water may be used only in a completely closed system and all the water must be returned through the proposed diffusion well or wells or some other equivalent satisfactory structure to the same aquifer from which it was pumped.
2. No overflows or connections to sewers or cross-connections to any other source of water supply may be installed or maintained.
3. Detailed plans showing each part of this project must have been submitted to and approved by this Commission before work is started on such part. ~~Plans of diffusion well to be submitted only after the stratification has been revealed by the sinking of the well.~~ The entire project must be fully completed in accordance with approved plans.
4. Applicant must install suitable connections to enable the discharge of the pump to be measured. Such fittings and the locations thereof will be specified by the Commission.
5. No chemical or polluting substance may be discharged in this water or into the diffusion well and the material used in this piping of the cooling system shall be of a nature reasonably resistant to corrosion which would pollute the water and tend to clog the diffusion well.
6. This entire plant and the apparatus connected therewith must at all reasonable hours be open to inspection and test by duly accredited agents of this Commission and of the local water authorities.
7. This decision and approval shall not be held to grant exemption from general restrictions of the use of water for this particular purpose which may at any time be imposed by competent authority.
8. The Commission reserves the right to reconsider this approval at any time and, after due notice and hearing, at that time to continue, rescind or modify this decision in such manner as may be found to be just and equitable.
9. Unless these works shall have been completely constructed prior to **July 1, 1963**, or within such extended time as may have been applied for and granted by the Commission, this approval shall be deemed to have lapsed.

In view of the above, the Water Resources Commission determines and decides that approval of this application will protect the public health and public welfare in conserving the supply of water of Long Island for domestic consumption.

Wherefore, the Water Resources Commission does hereby approve the said application, maps and plans as thus modified.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Water Resources Commission has caused this determination and approval to be signed and has caused its official seal to be affixed hereto and has filed the same with all maps, plans, reports and other papers relating thereto in its office in the city of Albany this 7th day of June, 1960.

To the Water Resources Commission of the State of New York:

The Petition of Edgecombe Construction Corp., respectfully shows:

First: Edgecombe Construction Corp., is a domestic corporation
formed under the laws of the State of New York.

Second: Jerry Spiegel, who signs and verifies this petition and
the undertaking submitted therewith, is the duly elected, qualified and
acting President of said corporation and he signs this petition and the
undertaking on behalf of said corporation by virtue of authority vested in
him by resolution duly adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors of
said corporation held on September 19, 1951.

Third: Applicant is to maintain a building at the above address
to be leased to the General Transistor Corp., of 95-18 Sutphin Blvd.,
Jamaica, New York; in which certain of its operations are to be carried on.
The property is owned by the applicant and is located on the northeast
corner of Cantiague Rock Road and ^{West} John Street, Hicksville, Long Island,
New York, as shown on the accompanying map.

Fourth: Applicant will require for air conditioning purposes about 55,000 gallons of water per day. It is desired to obtain this supply from a well to be located on the above premises.

Fifth: There is an existing well on the above premises, drilled under Preliminary Report No.N-6860. This well is an 8-inch diameter well drilled to a depth of 100-feet below ground surface. Applicant desires to increase the capacity of this well from 45-gallons to 150-gallons per minute. An electrically operated deepwell/^{submersible} pump is to be installed. Total annual use from this well will not exceed 5.5 millions of gallons.

Sixth: Applicant desires to use well water because it is much cooler than the public supply during Summer months and therefore more efficient for cooling purposes. Also it is believed applicant can obtain the desired water more cheaply from a well than from the public mains.

Seventh: It is proposed to use this water in an economical manner and all water is to be diffused back into the ground through a Diffusion Well to be located about 200-feet southwest of the Supply Well. The Diffusion Well is to be constructed in accordance with the most modern design principals but details cannot be submitted until the supply well has been sunk and information obtained on underground formation at this location.

Eighth: Applicant believes this project can be carried out without injury to other interests, that the proposed works will be safe and suitable and that the quality of the water from the proposed well will be suitable for the purpose for which it is to be employed.

Wherefore, applicant respectfully prays that the Water Resources Commission approve of this well project.





Gentlemen:

On March 23, 1960, Eastern Well & Equipment Co., Inc., licensed well driller No. 251 reported that you had engaged it to put down a well at Jerry Spiegel Associates, northeast corner of Centiague Rock Road and John Street, Hicksville, such well to be 3-inches in diameter, about 150 feet deep and equipped with a pump of 45 gallons a minute capacity.

This report has been returned to the said driller with an endorsement which will permit the construction of the well.

Your attention is called to the following: Any well put down on Long Island with an installed capacity of more than 45 gallons a minute must, before it legally can be sunk, have the approval of this Commission. Therefore, although you have the authority to put down the proposed well exactly as described, any material increase in the capacity of the pump installed in that well would constitute a violation of law and it is the duty of the Commission to prevent such violation.

You should, therefore, assure yourself that, when the work is completed, under no circumstances will the pump be capable of delivering more than 45 gallons a minute and to be on the safe side you should require the drilling company to install facilities with which they are familiar, to permit us to make a measurement of the discharge in order that we may be assured that there is no violation of law.

Furthermore, the maximum capacity of the pump must be limited by some permanent construction which cannot readily be tampered with. Throttling of the pump discharge by a valve in order to reduce the delivery will not be satisfactory and will be regarded as an attempt at evasion of the law.

It is requested that you acknowledge this letter stating that you are aware of the situation and that, when the well is completed, you advise us in order that it may be scheduled for future inspection.
