Actions Taken This Period

- Completed the loading and transported of stockpiled soil characterized as hazardous waste to the Heritage facility in East Liverpool, Ohio for disposal incident free.
- On January 14, 2014, the PA USDA permits for transfer of soils from our site which is located within an area defined as a golden nematode quarantine area were finalized allowing transport and disposal of the remaining excavated material to GROWS landfill.
- Indicated loading and transport of remaining stockpiled soil characterized as nonhazardous waste to the Waste Management facilities in Chaffee (1 excavated cell) and GROWs.
- The soil in stockpile 14 was resampled and analyzed for waste classification due to an inconsistency in laboratory analytical results.
- Continued coordination with NYSDEC and other stakeholders regarding IRM activities.
