On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), Leidos, Inc. is submitting this Progress Report to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) in accordance with the Order on Consent and Administrative Settlement for the former Gulf Oil Terminal in Oceanside, New York (NYSDEC Site #130165). On December 7, 2017, NYSDEC and CEMC agreed to quarterly progress reporting in lieu of monthly reporting.

#### **ACTIONS TAKEN THIS PERIOD**

- Coordinated with NYSDEC and other stakeholders.
- The Feasibility Study was submitted to NYSDEC on January 31, 2018.
- A Work Plan for Monitoring Well Replacements letter was submitted to NYSDEC on March 19, 2018.
- Drilling and installation of five of the six monitoring wells proposed for replacement (AMW-7, MW-18R, MW-24-D1, MW-27-D1, and MW-24-VD) was completed between March 19 and 28, 2018. Monitoring well construction logs will be submitted in the second quarter 2018 Progress Report.

#### **ACTIONS PLANNED FOR NEXT PERIOD**

- Coordinate with NYSDEC and other stakeholders.
- Drilling and installation of the sixth monitoring well (OW-3-D1) proposed for replacement.

- Surveying ground and top-of-casing elevations of all six newly installed monitoring wells.
- Gauging of accessible wells and deployment of Hydrasleeves™ tentatively planned during the first half of the second quarter with removal of Hydrasleeves™ during the latter half of the second quarter.


