INACTIVE HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL SITE (#152113)

VILLAGE OF FARMINGDALE, SUFFOLK COUNTY

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) announces that the printed Record of Decision (ROD) for the Hazardous Waste Disposal (HWD) Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site # 152113, Village of Farmingdale, Suffolk County, is available. The ROD presents the selected remedy for the HWD site and the rationale for the chosen remedy.

NYSDEC held a public meeting on September 28, 2004, presenting the proposed remedial action plan for the HWD site and receiving public comments on the proposal. The comments received at this meeting and during the public comment period (September 14, 2004 through October 14, 2004) were considered along with the administrative record for the site in preparing the final ROD. The ROD also contains a responsiveness summary addressing the public comments received.

The chosen remedial action plan described in the ROD includes:

- A remedial design program to provide the details necessary to implement the remedial program.
- A pre-design investigation to determine the extent of the downgradient groundwater plume and the optimum location for the injection/air sparging wells and performance monitoring wells.
- Treatment of source area soils using either of the following methods: *in situ* chemical oxidation or soil vapor extraction (SVE).
- Treatment of on-site and off-site groundwater by either of the following methods: *in situ* chemical oxidation or air sparging.
- Continued operation, maintenance and monitoring of the active slab depressurization (ASD) system interim remedial measure (IRM) at the former R&D Carpet and Tile building.
- Development of a site management plan to address residual contamination and any use restrictions.
- Imposition of an environmental easement.
- Annual certification of the institutional and engineering controls.
