As established in New York State Part 373 regulations, permitted facilities are required to maintain an information repository through their permit's life. Due to the large volume of administrative records in Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve Plant (NWIRP) repository system, the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) recognizes that the public can review and download information more readily than by submitting a Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) request.
