The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (the "Department") has reviewed Safety-Kleen's "Q2 2017 Groundwater Monitoring Program Report" dated July 21, 2017. The report provides the results of the June 2017 groundwater sampling event.

Upon review, the Department has the following comments:

- The Department is encouraged by the continued decreasing trend of Mineral Spirits concentrations in site groundwater wells.
- Review of the analytical results indicate favorable responses to the BOS 200
 injection program with reductions in contaminant concentrations and mass in the
 smear and vadous zones. A reduction of sampling frequency from quarterly to semiannual will not negatively affect the monitoring of the facility's groundwater and is
 approved.
- ORC filter socks are no longer necessary in monitoring wells GT-3 and GT-5.
