The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (the "Department") has reviewed Safety-Kleen's "Q3 2017 Groundwater Monitoring Program Report". The report provides the results of the September 2017 groundwater sampling event.

Upon review, the Department has the following comments:

- The Department is encouraged by the continued decreasing trend of Mineral Spirits concentrations in site groundwater wells.
- The presence of Mineral Spirits Range Organics (MSRO) in Quality Assurance (QA) samples associated with samples from wells VE-1R, GT-1 & GT-6 resulted in the proper qualifier of "B" to the results. While these monitoring points have historically detected the presence of MSRO, the results should be viewed with caution.
