Dear Mr. Fleming:

Thank you for your Affidavits of Publication and Radio Announcement published during the week of January 29, 2024. A Request for No Further Action and Cessation of Corrective Action Groundwater Monitoring Completion was made to the Department via letter dated March 9, 2021. Based on staff review and analysis of several years of monitoring data showing that groundwater concentrations met or exceeded New York State Drinking Water Standards, the Department concurred that the facility met compliance obligations as required under Part 373 Order on Consent #CO1-20020715-293 (Order) issued on June 19, 2003. As such, the Department public noticed in its Environmental Notice Bulletin from January 31 through March 18, 2024. The Department did not receive any comments on this public notice, so no Responsiveness Summary is required.

Therefore, the Department has hereby determined that Safety Kleen North Amityville has met Part 373 Corrective Action and Post Closure Care requirements contained in the aforementioned Order. You may now discontinue all sampling, testing, recording, monitoring and recordkeeping required by the Order as it has been completed.
