## CAMP MONITORING REPORT

# 545 Sackett Street 04/03/23 through 04/09/23

This Weekly Air Monitoring Report summarizes perimeter air monitoring data collected during the referenced period in accordance with the Community Air Monitoring Plan (CAMP) which was included as part of the NYSDEC approved Remedial Action Work Plan for the Former Fulton Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) Site – Parcel III and Portion of Parcel IV. Continuous monitoring for total volatile organic compounds (TVOCs) and airborne particulate dust ( $PM_{10}$ ) concentrations are being collected at five air monitoring stations (AMS-1 through AMS-5) around the perimeter of the Site and periodically along Degraw Street using handheld equipment. The program includes compound-specific monitoring for benzene and tri-chloroethylene (TCE) if TVOC concentrations are detected above the alert level (i.e., 3.75 ppm above background) at the air monitoring station.

#### **Work Performed**


- Performed community air monitoring.
- Moved construction materials and equipment in preparation for relocating the construction trailer.
- Transported non-hazardous concrete offsite for disposal.

### **Air Monitoring Summary**

There were no TVOC concentrations above the CAMP-established action levels, or observations of dust or odors associated with the Site during the monitoring period.

After work hours on Friday, there were windy conditions at the site and AMS-5 recorded an elevated 15-minute average  $PM_{10}$  concentration of 0.17 mg/m<sup>3</sup>. No work was being performed at the time (after work hours).
