# **Remedial Action Work Summary**

## **Work Activities Performed Onsite:**

- Cleaning and decontamination of heavy machinery that is no longer needed on Site.
- Management of swell and construction wastewater.
- Soil importing and foundation work.

ENTACT performed swell management throughout the day. Atmos 600 odor suppressing foam was applied when soil/ swell was disturbed and poly sheeting covered exposed material at the end of soil handling activities. Dust and odor control measures (application of Atmos odor suppressing foam, wetting, tarping, limiting vehicle speeds, covering trucks prior leaving the site, etc.) continued to be performed to ensure there were no impacts to the neighborhood. Construction wastewater was transferred to the onsite frac tank for storage and treatment to be discharged later to the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (NYCDEP) combined sewer system. Onsite equipment was relocated, decontaminated and prepped for demobilization.

Kingdom Associates Inc. (Kingdom) continues foundation installation in PA1 & PA2. Concrete forms, vapor barrier/ waterproofing and SSDS piping was installed throughout the day. Five trucks with clean fill were imported to the site to be placed around completed foundation elements. Kingdom continued installation of support of excavation in preparation for placing ConEd vaults under the sidewalk along Sackett Street.

# Air Monitoring:

- No VOC or dust exceedances were observed from the community air monitoring program (CAMP).
- GZANY to provide a summary report of CAMP activities separately.

# Vibration Monitoring:

- No alerts of vibrations exceeding Site's threshold or limiting criteria (1" /second and 2"/ second, respectively) were received.
- Vibration monitoring data is included at the end of this Daily Status Report.

A weekly SWPPP inspection was conducted

- Demobilization of heavy equipment from the Site.








