CAMP MONITORING REPORT

545 Sackett Street 09/08/25 through 09/14/25

This Weekly Air Monitoring Report summarizes perimeter air monitoring data collected during the referenced period in accordance with the Community Air Monitoring Plan (CAMP) which was included as part of the NYSDEC approved Remedial Action Work Plan for the Former Fulton Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) Site – Parcel III and Portion of Parcel IV. Monitoring for total volatile organic compounds (TVOCs) and airborne particulate dust (PM₁₀) concentrations is being conducted at five air monitoring stations (AMS-1 through AMS-5) around the perimeter of the Site. The program includes compound-specific monitoring for benzene and tri-chloroethylene (TCE) if TVOC concentrations are detected above the alert level at the air monitoring station.

Work Performed

- Performed community air monitoring.
- ENTACT consolidated and loaded out ISS swell to WM Fairless for disposal.
- ENTACT loaded out non-hazardous soil to Clean Earth for disposal.
- ENTACT performed general housekeeping, received deliveries, and refueled equipment.
- Kingdom Associates Inc continued to construct the building foundation in the southwestern portion of the Site and install an electrical vault along Sackett Street.

Air Monitoring Summary

There were no TVOCs or PM_{10} concentrations detected, or odors observed above the CAMP-established action levels. There were no observations of dust associated with the project leaving the Site during the monitoring period.

Figure 1 - CAMP Air Monitoring Station Locations

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


Figure 3 – Summary of PM₁₀ Concentrations 09/08/25 through 09/14/25
