<input type="checkbox"/> 4.1(a)	Unlawful discharge of concrete - washout box must be installed.
<input type="checkbox"/> 4.4(a)	Failure to take accidental spill precautions - spill prevention equipment must be installed.
<input type="checkbox"/> 4.4(b)	Failure to notify NYCDEP of accidental spill - must notify NYCDEP at (212) 966-7500 in the future.
<input type="checkbox"/> 4.4(c)	Failure to post accidental spill procedures - spill procedures must be posted.
<input type="checkbox"/> 4.6	Failure to install or maintain oil or grease interceptor - must install and maintain properly-sized interceptor.
<input type="checkbox"/> 7.1(d)	Discharge of scavenger wastes at a designated manhole not listed in permit - must discharge only at manholes listed in permit.
<input type="checkbox"/> 7.2	Discharge of scavenger wastes in an unclean manner - must discharge in a clean and lawful manner.

Specific details of corrective action
Must not allow any wastewater generated from the paint shipping process enter the city sewer system until further notice from IWCS DEP.

Failure to take the above-specified action may result in the issuance of Notices of Violation. Findings of violation carry penalties of up to \$1,000 per day per violation.
