PRE- DESIGN INVESTIGATION WORK PLAN December 2007

Amenia Town Landfill Site Town of Amenia, Dutchess County, NY Site No. 3-14-006

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), in consultation with the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) is providing this Fact Sheet to announce the availability of the "Pre-Design Investigation Work Plan" for the Amenia Town Landfill Site, located on the west side of Route 22, approximately 1.5 miles south of the intersection of NYS Routes 22 and 44 (see Site Location Map). This document is available for review at the four repositories listed in this Fact Sheet.

SITE DESCRIPTION

The site is a 10-acre, closed landfill, that accepted municipal and industrial waste from about 1940 until 1976. The site is now covered with trees and grasses. A pond/wetland and woods border the site to the west and north, and a wooded hill lies to the south.

REMEDIAL HISTORY

In 1998, the NYSDEC identified a drum disposal area with deteriorated and leaking drums in the southwest corner of the landfill. At the request of the NYSDEC, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) excavated and containerized approximately 170 drums of waste, along with adjacent contaminated soil. Removal and disposal of the wastes and soil were completed in the Fall of 1999.

In October 2001, a Consent Order was signed between the NYSDEC and the Amenia Landfill Group requiring a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS) at the site. The RI, completed in November 2003, showed that polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) were present in landfill soil and that PCBs from the landfill have impacted sediment in the adjacent wetland/pond. Elevated levels of some heavy metals were also identified in wetland sediment. Volatile organic compounds and petroleum contamination were noted in shallow on-site groundwater, but have not migrated off-site. In 2005, the FS was prepared and evaluated possible cleanup alternatives for the site. A Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) was presented to the public in January 2006 and the Record of Decision (ROD) was released in March 2006. The chosen remedial action plan described in the ROD generally consists of excavation of PCBs and heavy metals contaminated sediments from the adjacent wetland/pond and placement on the landfill surface, then construction of a low-permeability cap over the landfill surface.

PRE-DESIGN INVESTIGATION WORK PLAN

To assist in the development of the remedial design for this site, some additional investigatory work is planned to begin in December 2007. This work includes advancing exploratory test pits along the west side slope of the landfill to determine the extent of waste disposal along that slope; a sediment

probing survey; sampling and analysis of wetland/pond sediment to determine/confirm the horizontal and vertical extent of sediment requiring removal; and some additional soil sampling along the west slope to further delineate the PCB concentrations. This work is expected to be completed this winter as the weather permits. The data collected during this investigation will be used in the development of the remedial design to be submitted in the Spring of 2008.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION

The NYSDEC, in conjunction with the NYSDOH, is committed to establishing effective two-way communication with the public. The public is encouraged to make use of the Document Repositories to review the "Pre-Design Investigation Work Plan".



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FIGURE 1 - SITE LOCATION MAP


