Introduction

This report provides an update on the status of the Interim Remedial Measures currently underway at the Apple Valley Shopping Center Superfund Site (the "Site") for the period November - December 2005. These activities conform to the NYSDEC-approved IRM Work Plan dated July 2, 2004, and Order on Consent.

Status Update: November 2005

- 11/1: Conrad Geoscience inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress.
- 11/2: Conrad Geoscience inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress. Trenches for water and electric lines from each recovery well were excavated.

 Conduit for water and electric lines were installed from Recovery Wells RW-1 and RW-2 to treatment shed.
- 11/4: Conrad Geoscience inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress. The recovery well pump control panel was installed. Conduit for water and

- electric lines were installed in Recovery Well RW-3. Excavated trenches were backfilled.
- 11/7: Site meeting with remediation contractor to inspect the original decommissioned air stripper and its components.
- 11/9: Site meeting with NYSDEC to discuss the groundwater remediation system installation.
- 11/10: Site meeting with project engineer to discuss and select sub-slab depressurization system vent and monitoring locations in Foodtown.

 Discussed and selected additional vapor intrusion monitoring locations. Inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress.
- 11/16: Conrad Geoscience inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress.
- 11/17: Conrad Geoscience measured static groundwater elevations in on- and off-site wells. Inspected groundwater remediation system installation progress.
