

Introduction

This report provides an update on the status of the measures currently underway at the Apple Valley Shopping Center Superfund Site (the "Site") for the period April – June 2006. These activities conform to the NYSDEC-approved IRM Work Plan dated July 2, 2004, and Order on Consent.

Status Update: April 2006

- 4/4: Submitted groundwater monitoring report to NYSDEC, summarizing baseline data and results from samples collected February 9 and March 9.
- 4/14: Conducted groundwater treatment system inspection and maintenance.
- 4/24: Conducted groundwater treatment system inspection and maintenance.

Status Update: May 2006

5/3: Conference call with NYSDEC and NYSDOH regarding vapor intrusion monitoring scope and schedule.

- 5/9: Conference call with NYSDOH regarding vapor intrusion mitigation options.
- 5/10: Received vapor intrusion mitigation and diagnostic specifications from NYSDOH.
- 5/12: Conference call with NYSDEC and NYSDOH regarding vapor and groundwater sampling data.
- 5/15: Inspected groundwater treatment and vapor mitigation systems. Met with site contractors to evaluate cost of installation of additional vapor mitigation systems at Absolute Pizza.
- 5/16: Collected Recovery Well, Monitoring Well and treatment system effluent samples (3 months after system start-up).
- 5/24: Conducted periodic treatment system maintenance. Met with pump contractor to coordinate for repairs to flow control devices.
- 5/25: Met with site owner and operators to select location for sub-slab vapor

- 5/31: Conference call with NYSDEC and NYSDOH to review vapor intrusion monitoring scope and schedule.

Status Update: June 2006

- 6/1: Commenced vapor intrusion monitoring at all previously monitored locations, and new Freshtown location.
- 6/2: Completed vapor intrusion monitoring.
- 6/6: Submitted groundwater sampling report summarizing results of May 2006 sampling.
- 6/8: Conference call with NYSDEC and NYSDOH regarding vapor intrusion monitoring program, and groundwater remediation.
- 6/14: Conducted inspection and maintenance of groundwater remediation system.
- 6/17: Submitted June 2006 vapor intrusion monitoring results.

- 6/19: Conference call with NYSDEC and NYSDOH regarding vapor intrusion monitoring data.
- 6/26: Conducted inspection and maintenance of groundwater remediation system.
- 6/27: Repaired groundwater effluent treatment system, re-routed air discharge piping.

Anticipated July – September 2006 Schedule:

- Venting of backfill surrounding grease trap piping connected to Absolute Pizza to prevent vapor movement along pipe bedding.
- Collection of groundwater samples, August 2006.
- Routine maintenance of groundwater extraction and treatment system.
- Submit proposed plan to NYSDEC/NYSDOH for vapor mitigation system at Pharmacy.
