

Monthly Status Update – March 2025
Wallkill Wellfield Site
City of Middletown, Orange County, New York

Liberty Environmental (Liberty) is pleased to provide this status update for the above-referenced property located in Middletown, Orange County, New York. The following activities were completed during the month of March 2025:

- A waste profile for the drummed investigation-derived waste (IDW) and other drummed waste was completed and approved by the disposal facility. Upon approval by the facility, a pickup date was scheduled and waste manifests were prepared to track the shipment of the drums.

The following activities are planned for the site. The anticipated completion dates listed below are subject to change:

- Disposal of the drums was completed April 1, 2025. Fourteen drums containing wastes and 7 empty drums were removed from the property during these activities. A table below provides a summary of the waste drums that were removed. Two of the drums (oil/sludge drum and emulsion drum) were placed in overpacks because the conditions of the drums were not suitable for transportation. Documentation of the drum disposal will be submitted with the next monthly status update.

Waste Type	No. of Drums	Location
Soil	4	2 inside the building and 2 outside on the loading dock at the southwest building corner
Water	8	3 inside the building and 5 outside along the south central side of the building
Oil/Sludge	1	A small drum on the loading dock at the southwest building corner
Dow Corning 346 Emulsion	1	A drum containing a white emulsion located inside the building near the southeast corner

- A response to EPA's comment letter, dated December 17, 2024, was prepared and submitted for review and comment. The response letter proposed several action items including the installation of additional delineation monitoring wells, groundwater sampling for natural attenuation parameters, soil remedy confirmation sampling and a plan

for monitoring well maintenance. Scheduling of the action items proposed in the response letter will be performed following EPA's review and comment. Please note that some of the proposed work will take place on adjacent properties and will require access agreements to complete.
