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## ENVIRONMENTAL NOTICE

To be issued in lieu of Environmental Easement/Deed Restriction as referenced in DER-33

THIS ENVIRONMENTAL NOTICE is made the <u>leth</u> day of <u>October</u> 2024, by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department), having an office for the transaction of business at 625 Broadway, Albany, New York 12233.

WHEREAS, a parcel of real property identified as Tuxedo Waste Disposal Site (Site # 336035), located at 462 Route 17, in the Town of Tuxedo, County of Orange, State of New York, which is part of lands conveyed by Patricia J Iazzetti to Patricia J Iazzetti, as Trustee for the Patricia J. Iazzetti Living Trust by deed dated July 25, 2022 and recorded in the Orange County Clerk's Office on July 24, 2023 in Book 15449 of Deeds at Page 471 and being more particularly described in Appendix "A", attached to this noticed and made a part hereof, and hereinafter referred to as "the Property" is the subject of an Order on Consent executed by Ronald Iazzetti as part of the Department's State Superfund Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department approved a cleanup to address contamination disposed at the Property and such cleanup was conditioned upon certain limitations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Department provides notice that:

FIRST, the Property subject to this Environmental Notice is as shown on a map attached to this Notice as Appendix "B" and made a part hereof.

SECOND, unless prior written approval by the Department or, if the Department shall no longer exist, any New York State agency or agencies subsequently created to protect the environment of the Sate and the health of the State's citizens, hereinafter referred to as "the Relevant Agency," is first obtained, where contamination remains at the Property subject to the provisions of the Site Management Plan ("SMP"), there shall be no disturbance or excavation of the Property which threatens the integrity of the engineering controls or which results or may result in a significantly increased threat of harm or damage at any site as a result of exposure to soils. A violation of this provision is a violation of 6 NYCRR 375-1.11(b)(2).

THIRD, no person shall disturb, remove, or otherwise interfere with the installation, use, operations, and maintenance of engineering controls required for the Remedy, including but not limited to those engineering controls described in the SMP and listed below, unless in each instance they first obtain a written waiver of such prohibition from the Department or Relevant Agency.

FOURTH, the remedy was designed to be protective for the following uses: its current use as a closed landfill. Therefore, any use for purposes other than as a closed landfill, the express written waiver of such prohibition by the Relevant Agency may result in a significantly increased threat of harm or damage at any site.

FIFTH, no person shall use the groundwater underlying the Property without treatment rendering it safe for drinking water or industrial purposes, as appropriate, unless the user first obtains permission to do so from the Department or Relevant Agency. Use of the groundwater without appropriate treatment may result in a significantly increased threat of harm or damage at any site.

**SIXTH**, it is a violation of 6 NYCRR 375-1.11(b) to use the Property in a manner inconsistent with this environmental notice.

All that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate in the Town of Tuxedo, County of Orange, State of New York, lying Easterly of New York State Route 17 Tuxedo-Harriman, Part 1 S.H. No. 8258, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Easterly 1925 highway boundary of New York State Route 17 Tuxedo-Harriman, Part 1 S.H. No. 8258 at its point of intersection with the division line between the lands now or formerly of Patricia J. Iazzetti as described in Book 13116 at Page 421 on the North and other lands now or formerly of Patricia Iazzetti as described in Book 12698 at 1372 on the South and runs thence from said point of beginning along said Easterly 1925 highway boundary of New York State Route 17 the following three (3) courses: 1) North 03 deg. 16 min. 08 sec. East 224.37 feet to a point; (2) North 14 deg. 52 min. 50 sec. East 234.58 feet to a point; and (3) North 21 deg. 47 min. 35 sec. East 137.45 feet to its point of intersection with the Southeasterly 1937 highway boundary of New York State Route 17 Tuxedo-Harriman Part 1 S.H. No. 8258; thence along said Southeasterly 1937 highway boundary North 29 deg. 36 min. 35 sec. East 83.68 feet to its point of intersection with the Easterly 1937 highway boundary of New York State Route 17; thence along said Easterly 1937 highway boundary the following two (2) courses: 1) North 21 deg. 50 min. 10 sec. East 105.96 feet to a point; and 2) North 14 deg. 21 min. 40 sec. East 87.86 feet to its point of intersection with the division line between the said lands now or formerly Patricia J. Iazzetti as described in Book 13116 at Page 421 on the Southwest and the lands now or formerly of Renard A Barone and Sarkis Khourouzian as described in Book 2436 at Page 77 on the Northeast; thence South 54 deg. 55 min. 53 sec. East along the last mentioned division line 299.04 feet to its point of intersection with the division between the said lands now or formerly of Patricia J.
