State Superfund Site Classification Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program (the State Superfund Program) is the State's program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (Registry). The site identified above, and located on a map on the reverse side of this page, has been added to the Registry as a Class 02 site that presents a significant threat to public health and/or the environment for the following reason(s):

- This site has been added to the United States Environmental Protection Agency's National Priorities List.
- Historical use and operations associated with mining at the site have resulted in elevated levels of arsenic in site groundwater and site soil including ten residential properties.

DEC will keep you informed throughout the investigation and cleanup of the site.


