Record of Decision

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) announces that the printed Record of Decision (ROD) for the B. Millens Scrapyard site ("site") located at 290 East Strand Street, City of Kingston, Ulster County is available for public review (see "Where to View the ROD," below).

On Wednesday, February 28, 2018 NYSDEC held a public meeting presenting the Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for the site. The comments received at this meeting and during the public comment period (February 14, 2018 through March 14, 2018), along with the administrative record, were considered in preparing the final ROD for the site. The ROD presents the remedy selected to address contamination related to the site and the rationale for the chosen remedy. A *Responsiveness Summary* addressing the public comments received is also included in the ROD.

Record of Decision

The following is a summary of the chosen remedy described in the ROD:

- Excavation of off-site soil and consolidation of soil beneath a site soil cover.
- Enhanced biological degradation of groundwater contaminants.
- Installation of a site cover to allow for commercial use of the site.
- An environmental easement placed on the property which will allow for commercial use of the site and restrict the use of groundwater at the site.
- Development and implementation of a Site Management Plan which will include site cover maintenance and groundwater monitoring.
