

NOTICE OF PERMIT TERMINATION

Notice is hereby given that the public is invited to comment on a final determination proposed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) that the facility's RCRA permit may be terminated as RCRA Post-Closure Care (PCC) and Corrective Action (CA) at the facility are complete. The proposed determination is described in a Fact Sheet developed by New York State's RCRA Program. The Fact Sheet provides further details on the proposed determination.

Proposed Determination:
NYSDEC has determined that remedial actions to address contamination related to the Safety-Kleen Thornwood site in Thornwood, New York have been completed. The Department believes that the remedial activities conducted at the site over the last thirty (30) years are protective of human health and the environment and satisfies the corrective action requirements.

Following this Public Comment Period and the Department's evaluation of any comments received, the Department shall either terminate the facility's PCC/CA permit or require the facility to take any additional actions that are warranted.
