### State Superfund Site Delist Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program is New York State's superfund program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (Registry). DEC has determined that this site no longer presents a threat to public health or the environment and is proposing to delist the site from the Registry for the following reason(s):

- Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) were not detected above screening criteria since 2021, and prior remedial activities have removed significant sources of contamination from the site. Therefore, reclassification of the site from a Class 4 to a Class C on the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites is warranted.

Public comments are being received before the decision to remove the site from the Registry is finalized. The public comment period will end **October 25, 2024**. A summary of any comments will be assembled and made available for viewing at our Central Office.

If DEC does not receive any new or additional information during this public comment period that changes the delist proposal, DEC will delist the site on or after **November 24, 2024**.
