Actions Taken to Comply with the Settlement Agreement During Previous Month (March):

- The status of the point-of-entry treatment (POET) system and non-POET location monitoring is provided in the attached tables.
- Water purged from Town of Petersburgh (Town) Well #2 during repairs that was pumped into the frac tank was unloaded and treated by Taconic by March 21, 2017.
- Taconic had the Town distribution system flushed on March 28, 2017.

<u>Plans, Reports, and Other Deliverables Required by the Settlement Agreement Completed and Submitted in the Previous Month (March):</u>

- Taconic submitted a revised Town Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Manual to include comments from New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), and Rennselear County Health Department (RCHD) for the Town Public Water Granular Activated Carbon (GAC) System on March 29, 2017.
- Taconic received comments from NYSDEC on February 27, 2017 and additional comments on March 22, 2017 on the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan submitted on December 20, 2016. Taconic obtained an extension to address extensive comments by April 28, 2017.

Results of Sampling, Tests and Any Other Data Received or Generated by or on behalf of Respondent During the Previous Month (March):

• Analytical results were received from TestAmerica (TA) during the month for perfluorinated compounds (PFCs) for the mid-carbon and post-carbon quarterly samples collected from the POET systems and annual raw only properties and were submitted to NYSDEC under separate cover on March 1, 15, 17, 20, 22, and 29, 2017.

Activities Undertaken in Support of the Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) During Previous Month (March):

• Taconic received additional comments from NYSDEC on March 22, 2017 on the CPP update proposal submitted on March 1, 2017.

Actions, Plans and Data Scheduled for the Next Month (April):

- Submission of data validation report on April 6, 2017 for the accelerated RI analytical results associated
 with the groundwater and surface water samples collected from the Taconic site on September 1 and
 December 9, 2016.
- Analytical results are scheduled to be received from TA for PFCs for the mid-carbon and post-carbon quarterly samples collected from POET systems in March 2017.
- Analytical results are scheduled to be received from TA for the pre- and post-carbon samples collected from POET system(s) installed in March 2017 and cleared by the RCHD.

- Analytical results are scheduled to be received from TA for annual raw water only locations with no POET system collected in March 2017.
- WEL-DUN will continue quarterly maintenance monitoring of the POET systems in April 2017.
- WEL-DUN will continue annual sampling of the raw water in April 2017.
- Installation of POET system(s) not yet completed at locations included in Exhibit C of the Settlement Agreement will continue in April 2017.

Activities in Support of the CPP Anticipated for the Next Month (April):

• Updated CPP to address comments from NYSDEC on March 22, 2017, was submitted on April 6, 2017, and included providing a copy at the local document repository.
