Actions Taken to Comply with the Settlement Agreement During Current Month (April):

- Development of the Work Plan for Phase 2 Remedial Investigation continued in April 2020. The planned Scope for Phase 2 of the RI was discussed during teleconferences between Taconic and the NYSDEC on April 13 and 27, 2020.
- Change-Out of the GAC in the lead vessel at the Town of Petersburgh Treatment system was completed on April 28, 2020. Backwashing, rinsing sampling and re-starting of the vessel will be completed in May 2020.
- The status of the point-of-entry treatment (POET) system and non-POET locations monitoring is provided in the attached tables.

 Analytical results received during the month for the Town of Petersburgh treatment system were submitted to NYSDEC/NYSDOH/RCDOH on April 14, 2020.

- The GAC in the Lead vessel for the Town of Petersburgh Treatment System was changed-out on April 28, 2020. The Lead vessel will be backwashed, rinsed, sampled, and returned to service (as the lag vessel) in May 2020.
- Analytical results are scheduled to be received for the installed POET systems and raw water only locations with no POET systems.
- Sampling of the installed POET systems and raw water only locations with no POET systems will continue.
- Installation and maintenance services of POET systems will continue.
- Installation of POET system(s) not yet completed at locations included in Exhibit C of the Settlement Agreement will continue if accepted by the homeowners.
- Operation and maintenance support services for the Town of Petersburgh Treatment System will continue.

Delays Encountered or Anticipated and Mitigation Measures:

• In response to the COVID-19 health crisis, sampling of Residential POET systems was temporarily suspended between April 20 and May 13, 2020. On May 13, 2020, the NYSDEC and Taconic agreed to a limited resumption of the residential sampling program for those properties where the POET system could be accessed without entry into the occupied portion of the home or without significant interactive with the residents.
