Actions Taken to Comply with the Settlement Agreement During Current Month (September):

- Taconic received NYSDEC's approval of the Phase 2c RI Work Plan on September 12, 2023. Access agreements with
 property owners have been initiated to support the collection of environmental media samples on private property. Field
 work is anticipated to begin the week of October 23, 2023.
- Additional samples of eggs and syrup were collected on September 28, 2023, as part of the agricultural products sampling program (Phase 2b RI Work Plan).
- On September 26, 2023, the GAC in the lead tank at the Town of Petersburgh Treatment System was exchanged, and the tank filled with treated well water. On September 29, 2023, at the end of the required 72-hr soaking period, the new GAC was backwashed and rinsed to the on-site frac tank and will be treated back at the Taconic Plant. Confirmatory samples were collected on September 29, 2023. After satisfactory laboratory results are confirmed, this tank will be brought back on-line as the lag vessel.

- Installation of POET system(s) not yet completed at locations included in Exhibit C of the Settlement Agreement will continue if accepted by the homeowners.
- Operation and maintenance support services for the Town of Petersburgh Treatment System will continue.
