Thanks for everyone's time last week. As promised, attached are the following:

starting with Q2 2019 sampling event).

Additionally, here are a few answers to questions posed during the meeting:

1. RCRA status: the site is still listed as an LQG. The site submitted an annual hazardous waste generators report in February 2019 for CY 2018.

2. Site zoning: the site is currently zoned as I-2, which is industrial.

3. Regarding Scarlett's request regarding potable well research. This was last done in 2006/2007 and the summary is included in Section 3.2 of the 2007 Sampling & Analysis Report as follows:

"There are reportedly no potable or non-potable water supply wells on-site. No water supply wells were identified within one-mile of the Site in the Village of Rouses Point (north, east and south of the Site). An estimated four to six private water supply wells do exist southwest and possibly northwest (i.e., upgradient) of the Site in the Town of Champlain, according to local sources. Public water is provided to the Site and to the surrounding town by the Village of Rouses Point."

As part of updating this info, we looked at the NYS GIS Water Well inventory and the only wells in the area continue to be upgradient to the west/southwest (screenshot attached). Mark also reached out to the Clinton County Department of Health (CCDH) and requested current information. We will update you if we get any pertinent info from CCDH.
