SECTION 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 PROJECT BACKGROUND

This report summarizes the remedial action for the Lateral Control Pit (LCP) E-6. The remedial action was based on exceedances of NYSDEC Technical and Administrative Guidance Memorandum (TAGM) 4046 soil cleanup objectives identified by analytical results from soil boring samples collected during an investigation performed by FPM Group, Ltd. (FPM) in 2002. Exceedances were limited to samples collected at LCP E-6, near vent well LF6VMW1 and monitoring point MP-A. Further details of this investigation and a summary of the results can be found in the Draft Informal Technical Information Report, Chlorobenzenes Summary Report Apron 1 and 2 Areas (FPM, September, 2002).

Although petroleum contamination exists in the area of LCP E-6, the objective of this action was source removal of soils impacted by dichlorobenzene only. Petroleum contaminated soils in Apron 1 area are currently being treated by a bioventing system installed in 2002. The LCP E-6 site will be added to the biovent system in 2003.


1.2 SITE DESCRIPTION


The former Griffiss Air Force Base (GAFB) is located approximately two miles northeast of the city of Rome, county of Oneida, in central New York State. GAFB property covers approximately 3,540 acres and is situated in the relatively broad valley of the Mohawk River at an average elevation of 504 feet above mean sea level (AMSL).

Apron 1 is a former aircraft parking apron and refueling area and is located in the southeast portion of GAFB. Apron 1 is approximately 1,600 by 900 feet in size and is relatively flat, 18-inch thick, steel-reinforced concrete pad. Fifty-foot wide areas of asphalt paving on the northwest and southeast sides flank the concrete paving. The surrounding surface is unpaved lawn. The Apron 1 refueling system has been decommissioned with portions of the below ground piping closed in place. This decommissioning was conducted in the summer of 1996, as described in the Decision Document/Closure Report for Environmental Compliance and Closure Related Tasks at GAFB, Volume II, (Peer, 1997).

The apron has recently been used to stockpile petroleum-contaminated soil for on-site treatment and land-farming activities. Among the components of the Apron 1 refueling system were eighteen LCPs. Each LCP was a concrete structure that contained a floor and sump pit that housed fuel piping, valves, and other appurtenances. The LCPs supplied fuel to the 18 hydrants on the apron that contained spring-loaded poppets for coupling the fuel lines directly to the aircraft. LCP E-6 is located in the southeast portion of Apron 1. Figure 1.2 shows Apron 1, and the location of LCP E-6.

SECTION 2

REMEDIAL ACTIVITIES

2.1 SOURCE REMOVAL

2.1.1 Excavation

Source removal of contaminated soil at the LCP E-6 site was conducted on May 7, 2003, and May 8, 2003. The area of excavation was 25 feet by 25 feet area, to the depth of groundwater. Approximately 308 cubic yards (cy) of contaminated soil was excavated from the site. In addition, approximately 15 linear feet of 6-inch fuel line for the former hydrant E-6 were removed. Excavated materials were transported by Mangiardi Brothers Trucking for offsite disposal at the Ontario County Landfill. A total of 529.04 tons of materials were hauled to the facility. Copies of the waste manifests for material hauled to the landfill facility are provided in Appendix A.

Following excavation, confirmatory soil samples were collected from the excavation and sent for analysis as described in Section 2.3 of this report. The analytical results indicated that there were no exceedances of TAGM 4046 soil cleanup objectives for dichlorobenzene. Table 2.1 summarizes the results of the confirmatory sampling, and Appendix B contains the Preliminary Analytical Reports for the five samples collected.

2.2 SOIL SAMPLING AND ANALYTICAL RESULTS

2.2.1 Post Excavation Confirmation Sampling

Post-excavation confirmatory soil samples were collected from the four sidewalls and the bottom of the excavation and sent to Tri-Matrix Laboratories, Inc. of Grand Rapids, MI (Tri-Matrix) for analyses of dichlorobenzene using Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) method 8260B. A total of five confirmatory samples were collected from the area consisting of one grab sample from each sidewall and a composite sample from the bottom. All samples were collected in accordance with the AFCEE Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP) Version 3.1. The sidewall grab samples and the composite sample, which was comprised of five soil grabs from random locations off the bottom, were collected using decontaminated stainless-steel spoons and placed in precleaned, labeled sample containers, entered on a chain of custody form and shipped to Tri-Matrix in a cooler with ice for analyses. The preliminary analytical results indicated that no samples exceeded the TAGM 4046 dichlorobenzene cleanup criteria (Table 2.1).

2.3 BACKFILL AND FINAL RESTORATION

Once analytical results of the confirmation samples indicated that the area met the cleanup objectives, the security fence was removed, and the site was backfilled with

clean soil from the SAC Hill borrow pit. Topsoil, seed and mulch were installed to match existing site grades. Final site restoration was completed in May, 2003.

2.4 AIR MONITORING AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

During excavation, a PID was used to monitor the air in the breathing zone to detect volatile organic compounds, no readings above action levels were recorded. Level D personal protection was worn for the duration of the remediation work. No illnesses or injuries were reported during this remedial action.

2.5 DAILY FIELD REPORTS WITH PHOTOS

Daily field reports (DFR) including photographic documentation of the fieldwork, site conditions and progress were maintained daily, and are included as Appendix C.

SECTION 3

SUMMARY

3.1 SUMMARY

A total of 308 cy of soil was excavated from the LCP E-6 site, transported, and disposed of at the Ontario County Landfill. Post-excavation confirmatory soil samples collected from the sidewalls and bottom of the excavation area were analyzed for dichlorobenzene. Analytical results were compared to the NYSDEC TAGM 4046 soil cleanup objectives, to confirm that dichlorobenzene levels were below the recommended cleanup objectives. The site was backfilled, graded, topsoiled and seeded. Final site restoration was completed in May, 2003.

3.2 CONCLUSIONS

Based on the analysis of confirmatory soil samples collected from the excavation area, dichlorobenzene-impacted soils at the LCP E-6 site have been removed. The site has been remediated to meet the NYSDEC TAGM 4046 soil clean up objectives for dichlorobenzene, and the excavation area has been backfilled with clean soil and restored.










