A Significant amount of Ground Hornet nests were discovered during work. Work was partially paused due to the ground hornets and a small portion of the landfill cover remains un-mowed. Future mowing is recommended to occur when the weather is cold enough to allow the hornets to go dormant.

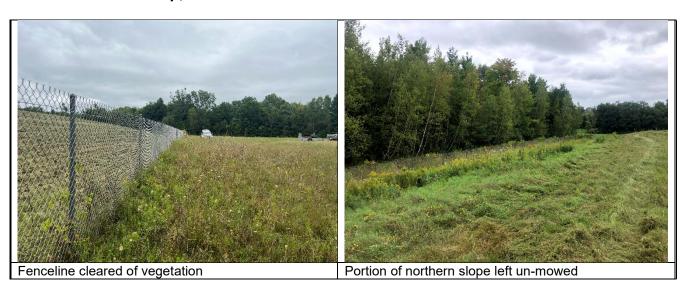
