SITE DESCRIPTION:

This site was used as a general industrial disposal area for the former CAF plant (currently Amitec Corporation). The site has reportedly <sup>also</sup> received a laboratory research wastes, although no records are available listing materials and quantities disposed. The site is covered with weeds or grass vegetation and is fenced.

Amitec Corporation does have production groundwater wells in its vicinity. These wells are not located to be satisfactory downgradient <sup>monitoring</sup> points. This site could be <sup>adversely</sup> potentially impacting the groundwater in its proximity (including downgradient flow zone), but no monitoring well points are available for sampling.
