State Superfund Site Reclassification Notice Class 2 to Class 4

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program is New York State's superfund program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites. The site identified above, and located on the attached map, has been reclassified on the Registry as a Class 4 site as it no longer presents a significant threat to public health and/or the environment for the following reasons:

- Remedial activities at the site included removal of on-site soils impacted with volatile organic compounds and metals exceeding 6 NYCRR Part 375 soil cleanup objectives (SCOs) within the former Landfill Area. Excavations were backfilled with NYSDEC approved material to original grade. Remediation also included the removal and off-site disposal of municipal solid waste, tires, and scrap metals (empty drums, storage tank, cars, and miscellaneous metals) from the Drum and Debris area. Confirmation sampling determined the remedy achieved cleanup to residential SCOs.
- Human exposures to residual contamination at the site are being prevented through implementation of an environmental easement and site management plan, which allows for continued enforcement of the easement. The easement restricts future use of the property to residential, restricted residential, commercial, or industrial, as described in 6 NYCRR Part 375-1.8(g). The easement further prohibits the use of groundwater as a source of potable or process water. The December 2023 Site Management Plan (SMP) includes provisions for continued groundwater monitoring and soil vapor intrusion sampling for any future on-site buildings that may be developed, including provisions to address potential exposures, if needed. Compliance with the approved SMP and annual certification by the property owner to NYSDEC will ensure that the institutional controls remain effective. The site and surrounding areas are served by a municipal drinking water source.
- Remedial actions have been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the March 2010 Record of Decision and measures are in place to prevent human exposures to contamination remaining at the site.
