2 excavators in stream bed, one is PC360

Ram hoe attachment breaking up rock in streambed at point number 26 along prison wall, opposite auburn tank building.

Eric Knapp said rock removal can't advance more than 75 feet from prison wall unless added concrete wall support is in place.

11:30 truck loaded.

CAMP monitors in place.

1:00 walked along streambed. Where weathered rock has been removed the surface is smooth, no tar observed on surface. Of the loose rock recently broken up, a small fraction (<5%) had tar on it. The tar was on low viscosity.

Off-site at 1:30

Issue: Significant amount of sediment remains to be removed along with backfill placement and prison wall support installation. I question whether Sevenson can complete the work before WQC expires.
