


<p>Conclusions: TCE levels of off site wells appear to be leveling off. Interior well TCE levels have fallen from a high of 300 $\mu\text{g/l}$. The lowest levels occurred in May and December of 1995. These wells showed a slight rebound in May 1996. but have again fallen to 1995 levels with most sample below 25 $\mu\text{g/l}$. Perimeter monitoring wells have leveled off at less than 20 $\mu\text{g/l}$ with most samples at less than 10 $\mu\text{g/l}$. However, off-site monitoring wells are showing low, but slightly increased levels of TCE. The highest off-site TCE levels are from CT-21, but only 3 results have been reported from this well. A map with the locations of the off-site wells has been requested to put these TCE levels in context.</p>

Comments: Verbal reports from the Cortland County DOH are that off-site levels of TCE increased substantially based on October sampling. These wells are being resampled to confirm. These results must be reviewed before commenting on the efficacy of the remedial system.
