Excavating soil above wood duct (larger size)
in front of #614 Court Street.

RT Backhoe used in conjunction with RT loader to
load trucks due to low overhead wires. Slow process.

CAMP is being adhered to.

Approximately 8' of wooden duct removed in front
of #614 Court Street. Duct was 1/2 full of hardened
tar. Excavation continued underneath duct to a depth of ~
8'.
all depths below grade
0'-1.5' Gravel
1.5'-5.0' dark (black) clay with MGP odor
5.0'-8.0' Green/Gray clay with hair like tar stringers
Below 8.0' dark gray coarse to medium sand MGP odor
with GW starting to seep in excavation

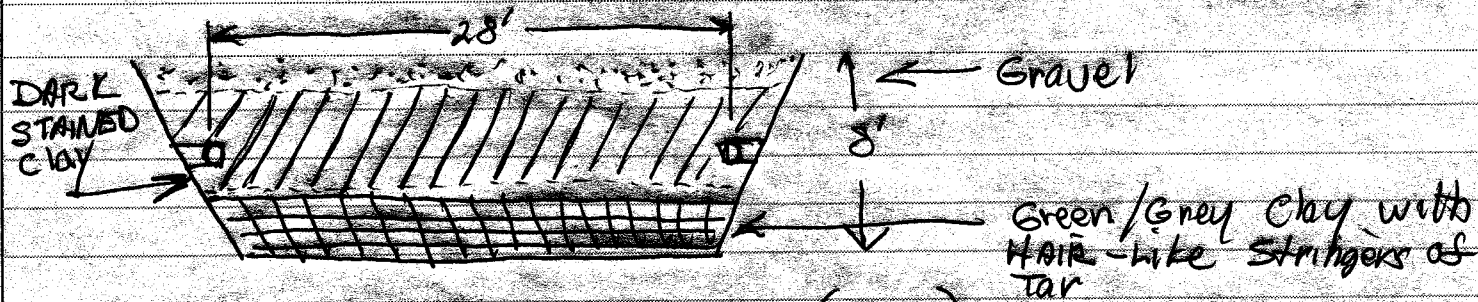
Odors are minimal due to cold temps and breeze.
Also, vapor control system working better due to longer trench.

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~ 28' of wood duct removed (total)
 ~ 8' depth of excavation. Third truck was filled after 1500 hrs., therefore Severson/ALM NYSEG decided to scrape the residual contamination from excavation bottom to the most eastern end. This material (contaminated) will be temporarily covered with 2' of compacted gravel and asphalt cold patch. It will be removed on Monday.
